Itinerary

Day 01: Yangon: Evening Cruise

Is the largest city in Myanmar (formerly Burma). A mix of British colonial architecture, modern high-rises and gilded Buddhist pagodas define its skyline. Its famed Shwedagon Paya, a huge, shimmering pagoda complex, draws thousands of pilgrims annually.

Today on arrival, you will be picked up and transferred for a sightseeing of Yangon. In the evening, Come discover the spectacular sceneries of Yangon's waterways and the rich

historical and cultural landscapes that lie along the banks of the Yangon River on the Sunset Cruise. Experience the beauty of Yangon in the final hours of its sunset while savouring the fresh evening breeze that comes through the Gulf of Martaban of the Andaman Sea. Observe the little-known Lighthouse of the Twante Canal and the buoy that indicates the whereabouts of Myanmar. Overnight at hotel in Myanmar.

Day 02: Yangon: City Tour

Yangon lies in the fertile delta of southern Myanmar, on the wide Yangon River. The city is filled with tree-shaded boulevards, while shimmering stupas float above the treetops. The city became the capital only in 1885, when the British completed their conquest of Upper Myanmar and Mandalay's brief period as capital of the last Burmese kingdom ended. Start the tour at the Sule Pagoda, a gleaming octagonal pagoda that stands squarely at the centre of the



city (Sule Pagoda is now under renovation with scaffolding process and cover with mat until further notice. However, the pagoda is still possible to visit inside as usual). Afterwards, visit the National Museum (closed on Mondays and Public Holidays) to gain an insight into Myanmar. See the eight meter high Sihasana Lion Throne, used by the last Burmese king, and other fascinating artefacts from Burmese history and culture. Finally, continue to the Shwedagon Pagoda, the highlight of any visit to Yangon. Towering over the city, this pagoda is the most sacred spot in the country, built to house eight hair relics of the Buddha. The Shwedagon and surrounding shrines are at their most beautiful during the sunset hour, as the golden stupa reflects the changing colours of twilight. Overnight at hotel in Yangon. (B)

Day 03: Yangon: Railway Market

Get up early morning for the lively local market activities at Danyingone Market, practically known as Railway Market. The Market is situated in Danyingone, outskirts of Yangon City. Transfer to the Yangon Railway Station first, wait for the daily circular train heading to Danyingone Market and may encounter vendors and hawkers carrying vast amount of vegetables to sell them at the local markets. Enjoy the circular train ride about nearly one and a half hour, after passing



through Insein station, you will discover the green fields, small wooden houses and some factories as a signal that you are out of Yangon city. Then the busy Danyingone market station awaits you with full of locals, vendors and hawkers selling & buying colorful vegetables, meats, local snacks and flowers. Some of the vendors and hawkers are selling on the railway, every time a train approaches, they carry the goods they are selling and move away from the railway. And once the train leaves the station, they come back and sell again on the railway. This lively scenery is one of the best local encounters and very lively for photo-shooting. Also pay a visit and walk around the main market where you will see locals buying, selling and carrying the

vegetables with motorcycles, trishaws, tuktuk and types of vehicles modified by locals. Discover local foods in the main market such as Mohinga, a rice noodle with fish soup, an essential Burmese cuisine and a typical breakfast for Burmese. Afterwards, return back to Yangon by car.

Day 04: Yangon – Heho – Inle Lake

Today take the flight to Heho where you will be transferred by road to Inle Lake. The Inle Lake is all worth the hype, surrounded by marshes and floating gardens, stilt-house villages and Buddhist temples, and Inthafisherfolk propel their boats along via their unique technique of leg-rowing, experience the countryside in a unique way. The evening is at leisure. Overnight at hotel in Inle Lake. (B)



Day 05: Inle Lake: Sightseeing tour

Enjoy a boat ride on Inle Lake and discover its calm serenity, still waters and colourful brush strokes of floating vegetation and slow moving fishing canoes. Rolling high hills hug the lake on all sides, as the lake's shore and islands host 17 villages on stilts, mostly inhabited by the Intha people. Enjoy the awe inspiring scenery and meditate on the one of a kind skill of the local fishermen who make use of their legs in a unique rowing technique to glide themselves gracefully around the lake. Visit



the enchanting floating gardens, a teeming market and an Intha village around the lake. The day also includes a visit to the PhaungDawOo Pagoda, Inn Paw Khon Village (Lotus and silk weaving villages) and the Nga PheKyaung Monastery. Overnight at hotel in Inle Lake. (B)

Day 06: Inle Lake: Day At Leisure

After breakfast, you have the day at leisure. Overnight at hotel in Inle Lake. (B)
